Call to Order by Chairman Dan Blatter 6:15 pm

Roll Call – Directors: Dan Blatter and Linda Nicodemus

Visitors – Tom Frederick (Harrison Twp. /St. Albans); Rob Platte & Charlie Prince (Union Twp.)

Approve Minutes – April 18, 2017 – Dan made a motion to accept the minutes as submitted. Linda seconded. The motion passed.

Treasurer's Report – \$1,923.89 – Dan made a motion to approve. Linda seconded and motion carried.

Old Business

- a. Finding another Director – Dan has not heard from anyone who had offered to speak to a few people regarding this vacancy.
- b. Log jam presentation - Ralph Wise (Village of Hebron Administrator) and Linda presented the Log jam information and the debris removal application from the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District to the County Commissioners today at the meeting. The images she could explain the magnitude of the blockage that extends around 500 feet. Linda stated that Boris Slogar (Chief Engineer with Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District) said that if the application could be completed and submitted they would be able to get it on the 2018 projects. The County Commissioners ask Denise Brooks (Licking County Soil and Water Conservation District Administrator) to fill the application and be the project lead. Joe Hart (Licking Township Trustee) attended the Commissioners meeting to support the project.
- c. Feeder Ditch – Dan stated that Jeff Martin and the County drone operator Jeff Robb were able to video most of the feeder ditch. Dan presented the video footage and discussed some of the problems that they found there. Most of the problems are due to age and lack of maintenance.

New Business

- a. Buckeye Lake Dam project – Linda had sent a shorter version of the log jam presentation to Jonathan Ferbrache (Fairfield Soil and Water) and he submitted it to Kevin Holtsberry with ODNR and the Buckeye Lake project group. But Mr. Holtsberry stated that it isn't within the scope of their project or in their jurisdiction. Charlie Prince discussed updates with the Buckeye Lake Project and issues with the contractor and the problems faced with them not allowing stormwater drainage into the lake. He said ODNR isn't concerned with the South Fork Licking River and the additional water that they are releasing.
- b. The June meeting was cancelled due to Linda's mission trip with her Youth Group.
