- IV. Minutes from May 24, 2022

DB moved to accept the minutes from May 24, 2022. KE seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

V. Treasurer's Report for May & June: Directors went over and discussed financial reports.

DB moved to accept the financial reports from May & June 2022. KE seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

VI. Old Business

- a. Intel (Emily Smith)
 - i. Emily Smith discussed early site prep work. She stated the site started being prepared Friday, July 1. Emily also stated that gravel has put down for temporary parking lots, and wheel washing/ street sweeping would be used to keep debris off roads.
 - **ii.** There will be an Local Citizen Advisory Panel, which is where Intel will interact with the community for updates and receive feedback. Emily said they should start next quarter.
 - iii. Significant sized landscaped berms with vegetation will screen the "Fab" buildings.

b. SLWCD Projects & Grants

- i. SLWCD Flood Damage Reduction Planning Study (Miles Hebert)-
 - 1. Miles discussed the data collection process that is ongoing. EMHT is working on a list of property owners for property access to ground truth issues in the watershed.
 - 2. Mayor Mark Johns spoke about the need of information being shared for those "downstream" of the cleanup sites. City of Heath is engaging with Verdantas to complete an H & H study.
- ii. Raccoon & Lobdell Creek Debris & Field Study and Snag & Clearing Grant (Kyle Seitz)-
 - 1. Kyle is working with the Silver Jackets, gathering and sharing information from the field.

c. Watershed Update

i. Fairfield County SWCD (Johnathan Ferbrache)- Via email- Stormwater Conveyance Study project update is on August 25th with Walnut Township (grade school auditorium)

ii. Licking County SWCD (Kristy Hawthorne & Kyle Seitz)-

- 1. Kristy stated ms consultants was the top ranking bidder in the RFP process for the South Fork Licking River Flood Modeling project. Ms consultants will work through the contracting phase with the Commissioners.
- 2. Licking Soil & Water is working closely with consultants that contracted to do comprehensive planning and zoning with 9 townships and 4 villages within Licking County currently.
- 3. Kyle noted there has been additional water testing per BLT request because there were high numbers last month.
- iii. Perry County SWCD (David Snider)- no updates

 - i. Craig Butler discussed the meeting- engaging with stakeholders, September timeframe draft to be done
